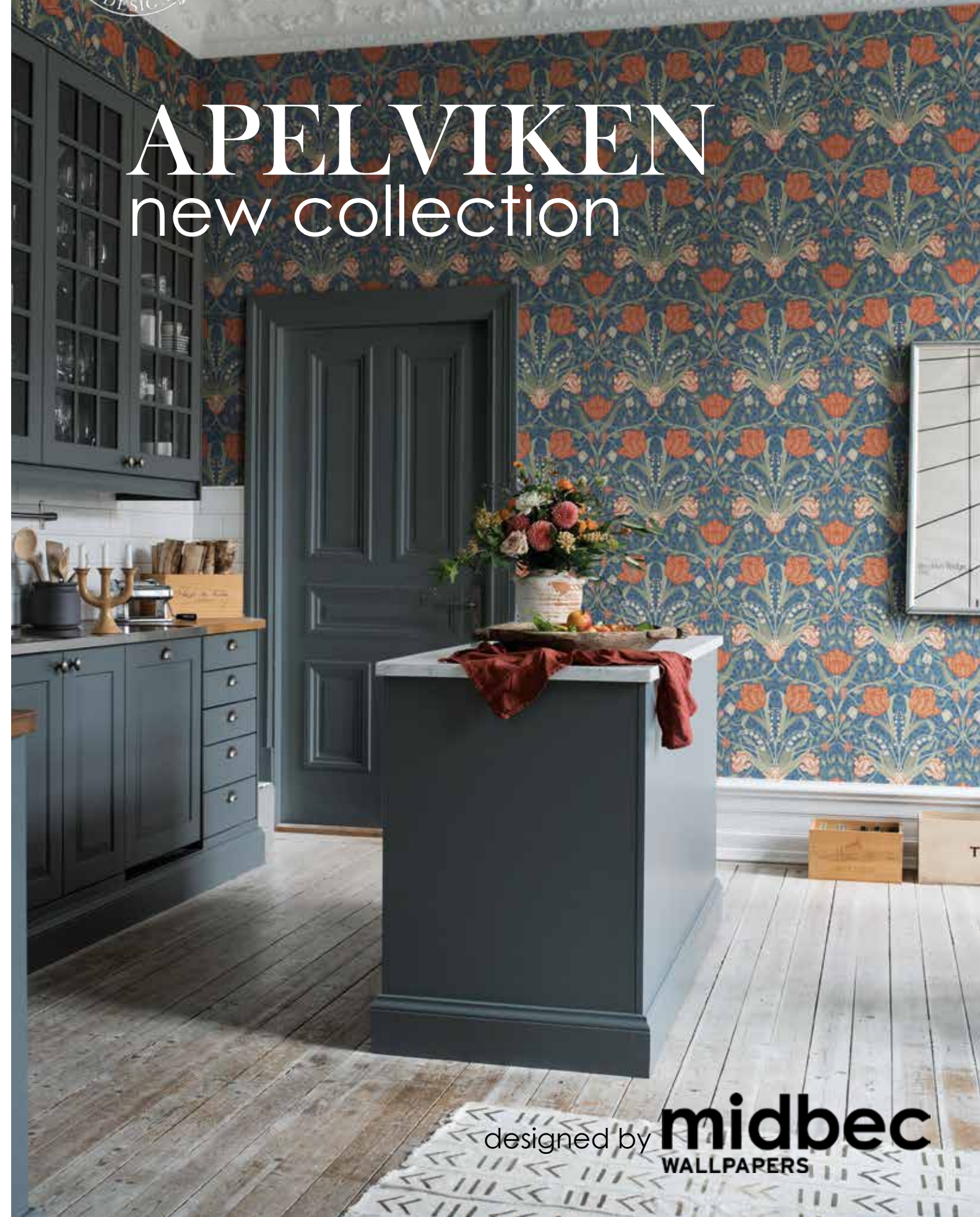

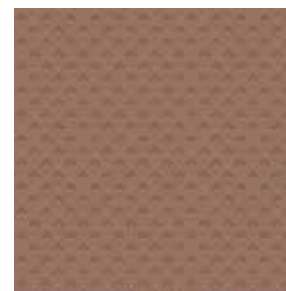
Apelkvist with its twisted twigs and shimmering leaves is a nice option for Anemone, Filippa and Pomona. Apelkvist is available in six different color settings
